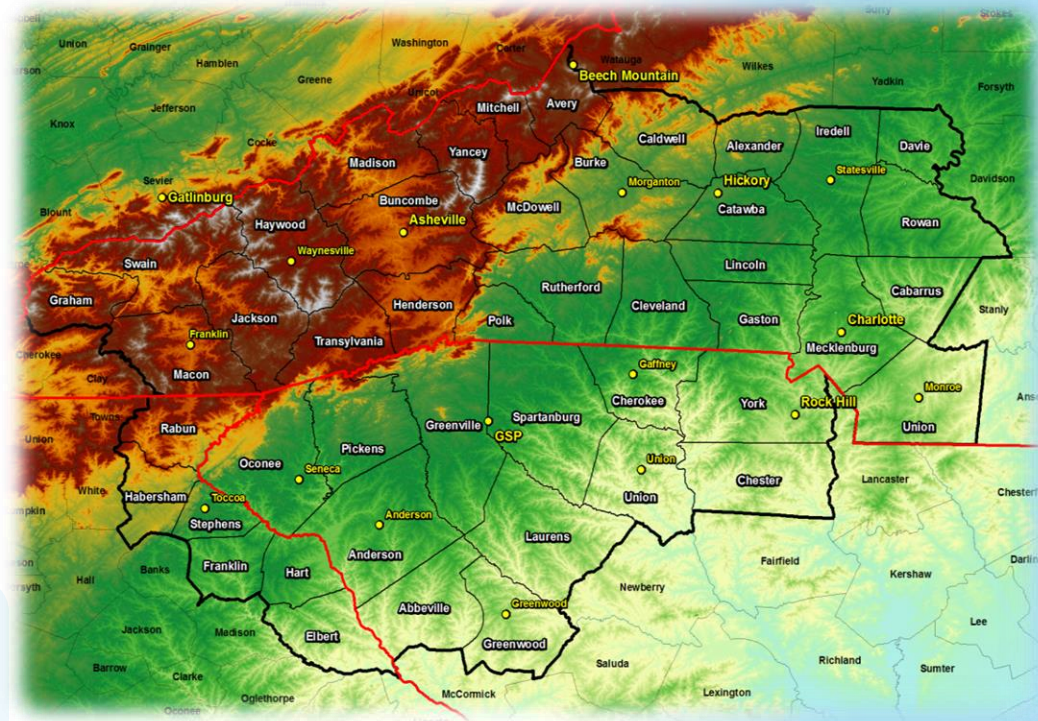


Severe Thunderstorms Expected Today

What Has Changed?

- ✓ Overall severe threat increased to Enhanced Risk
- ✓ Damaging wind and tornado risk increased



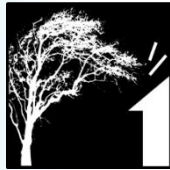
Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Tornadoes	A few tornadoes are possible in the stronger storms with intensely damaging winds over a small area.	All areas.	This afternoon and early evening.
Wind	Damaging wind gusts are the greatest threat. These winds may be as strong as weak tornadoes.	All areas.	This afternoon and early evening
Hail	Isolated large hail is possible in the strongest storms.	All areas.	This afternoon and early evening
Lightning	Frequent lightning is expected in many storms today. Cloud-to-ground lightning is possible in any storm.	All areas.	This afternoon and early evening
Flooding	Localized flash flooding may develop where repeated storms move over the same areas.	All areas.	This afternoon and early evening

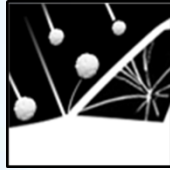

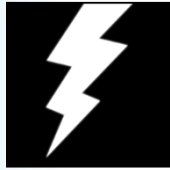
Tornadoes: All Areas



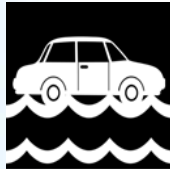
Damaging Wind: All Areas



Large Hail: All Areas



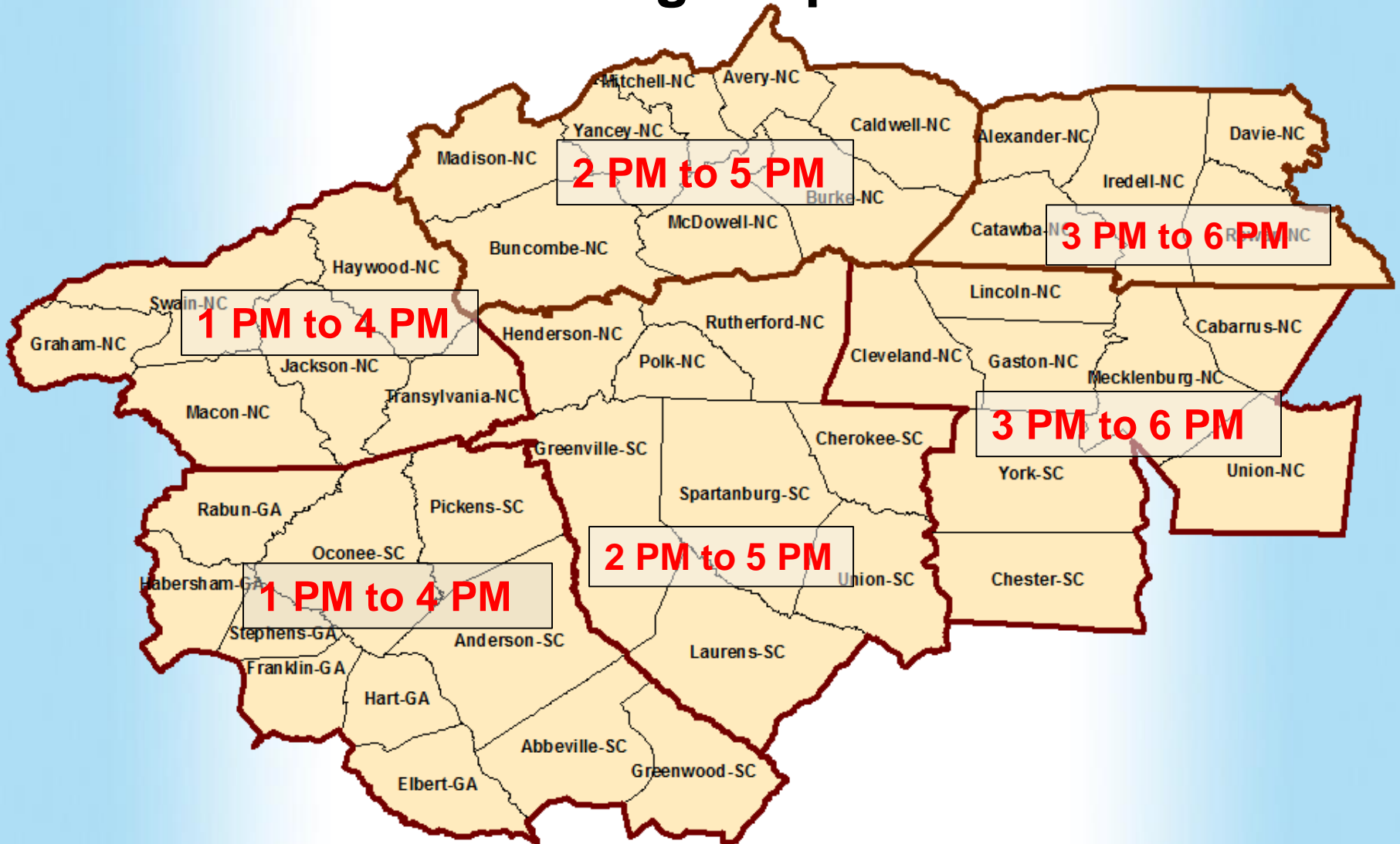
Lightning: All Areas



Flooding: All Areas



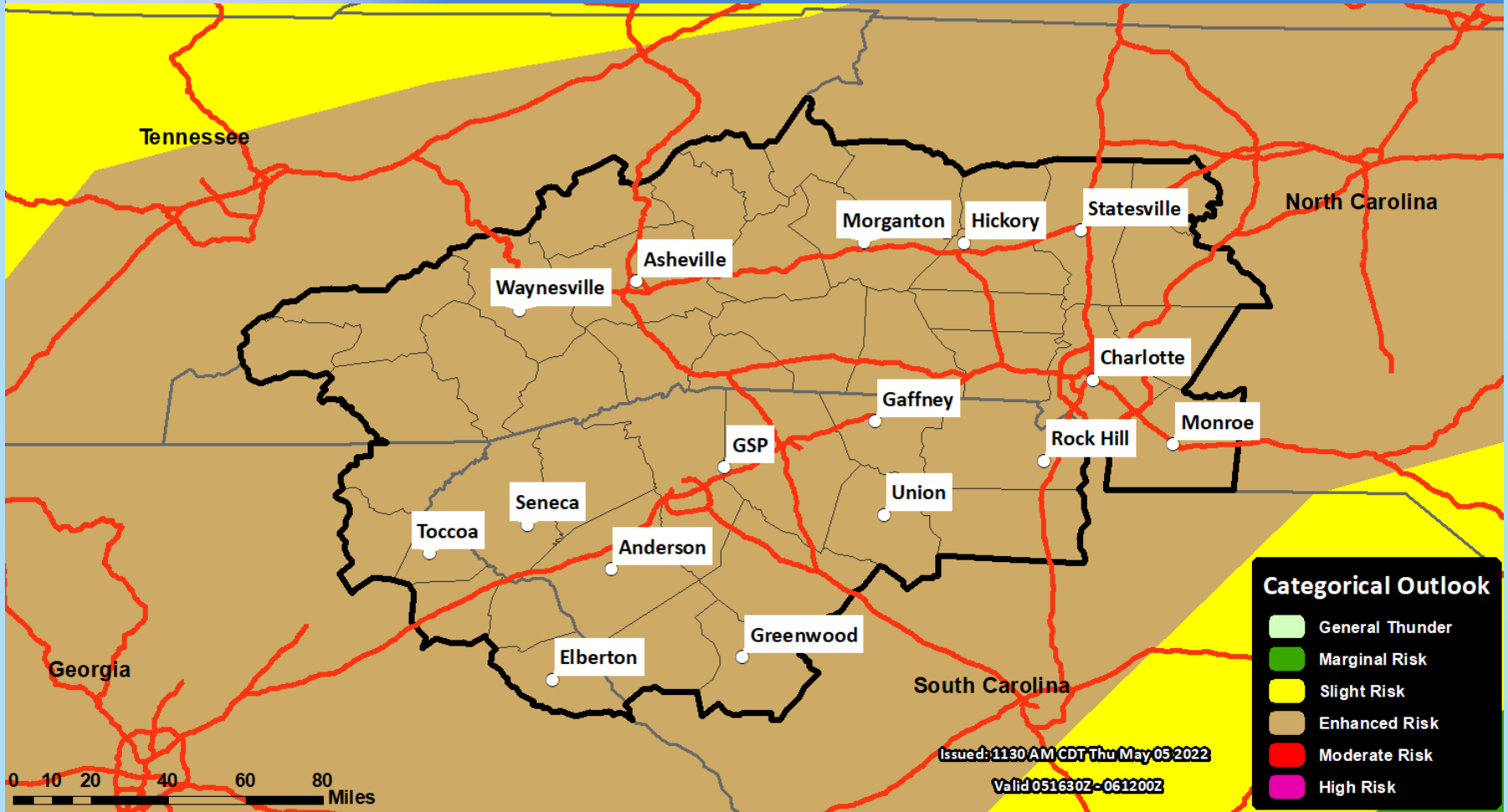
Timing Graphic

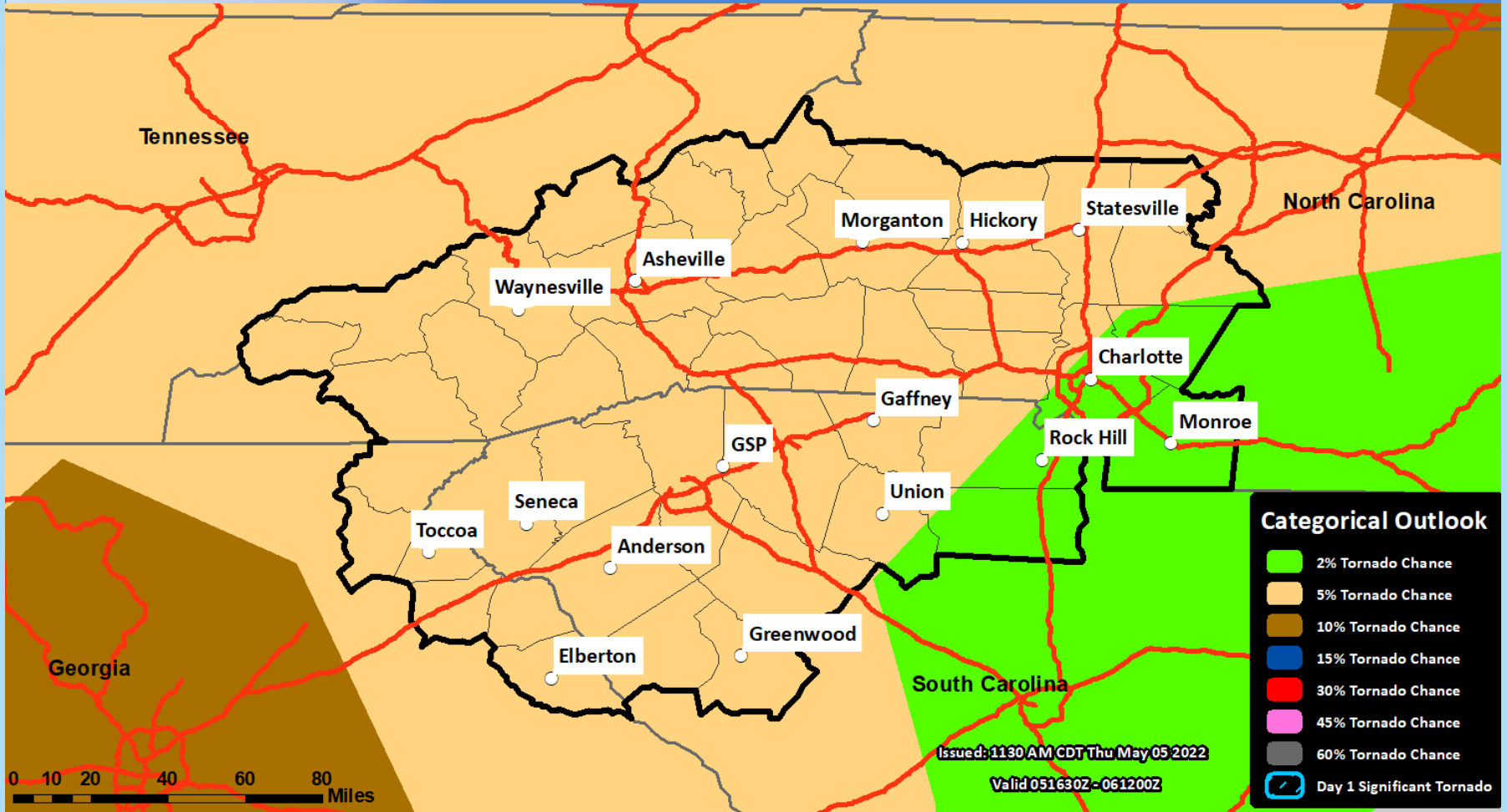

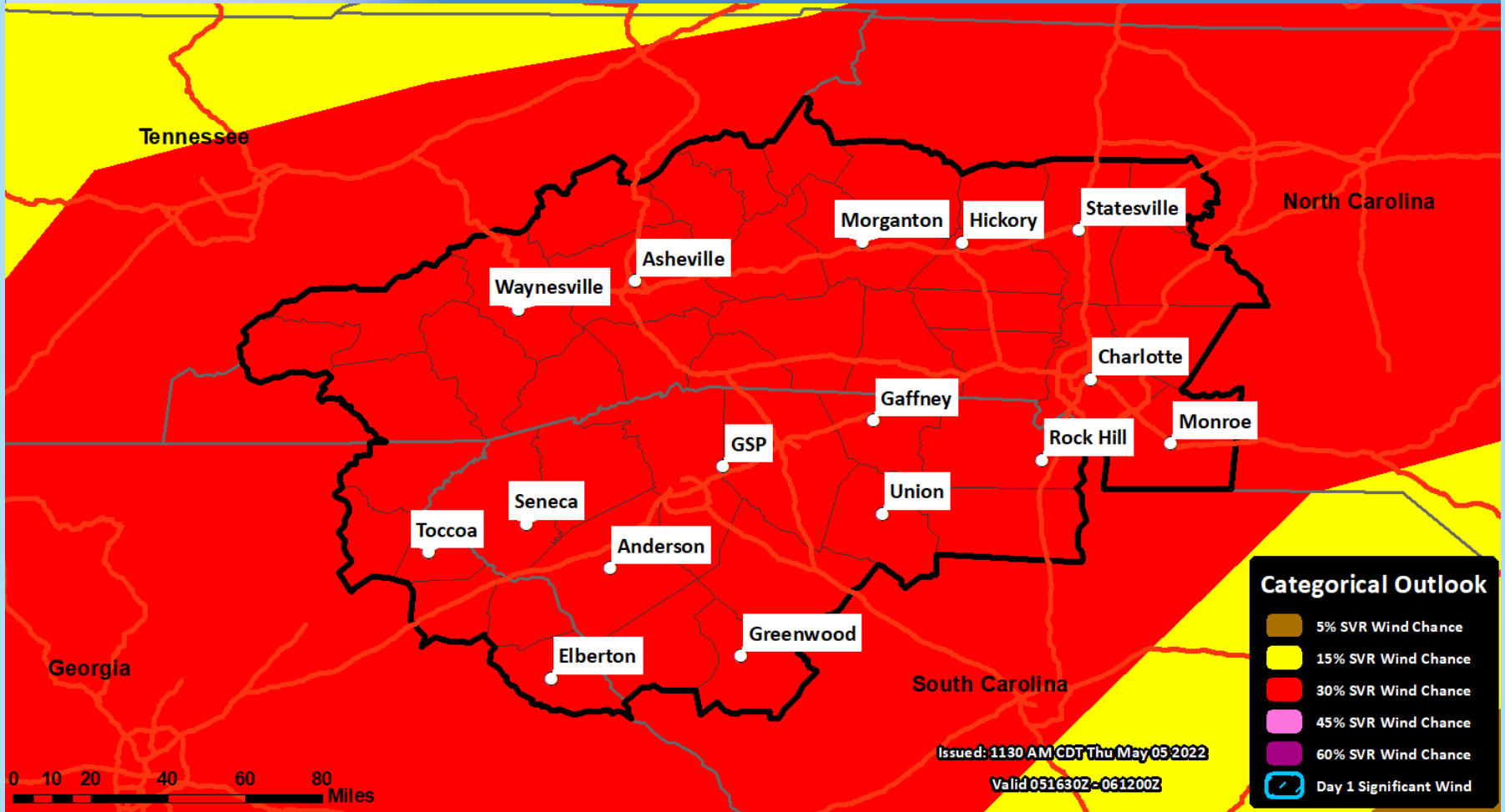

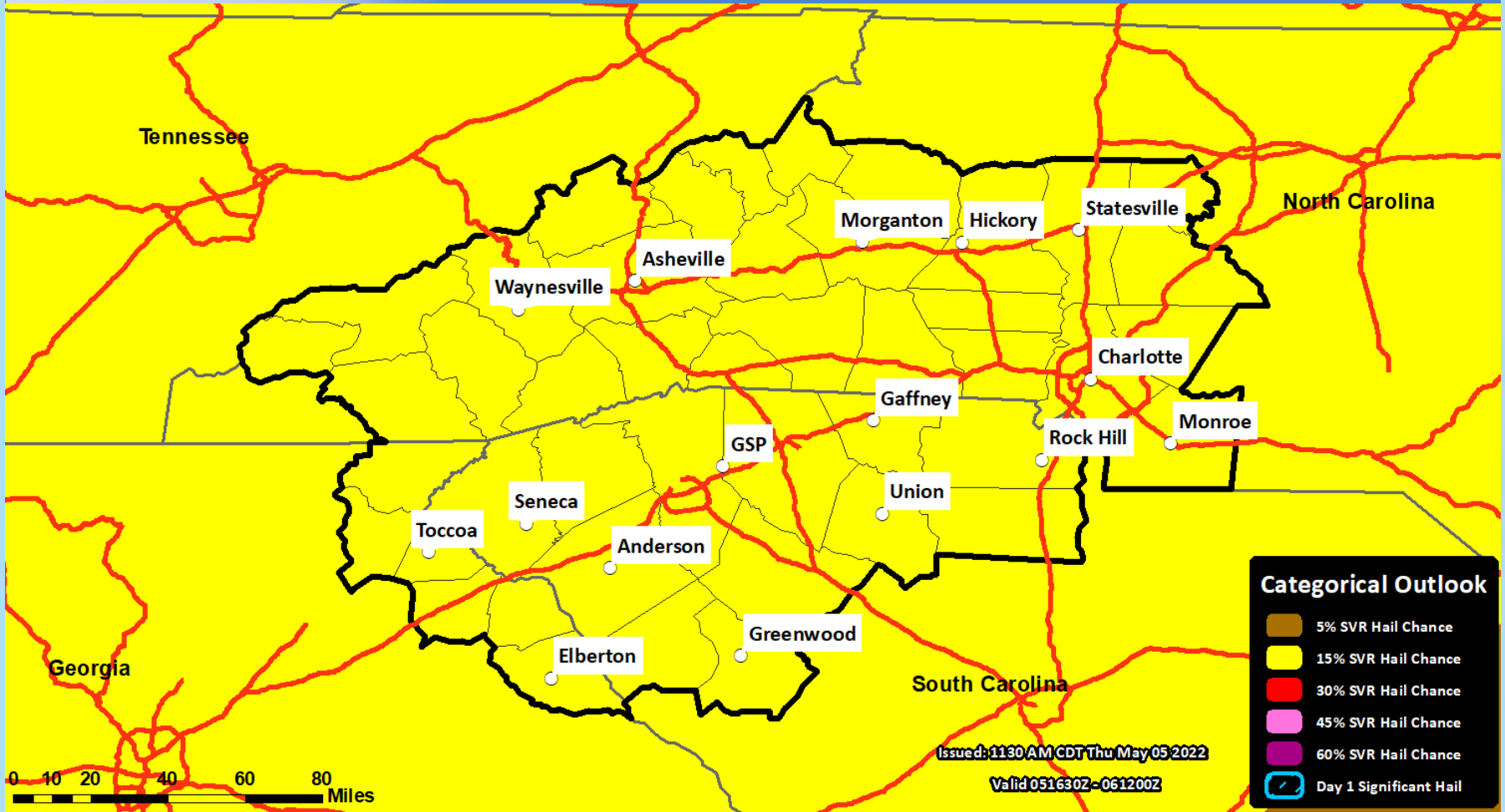

Event Summary (optional)

- ✓ Numerous to widespread showers and thunderstorms are expected today.
- ✓ The threat of severe storms has increased, and some of the storms will become severe this afternoon.
- ✓ Damaging winds and a few tornadoes are the main threats. The damaging winds can be as strong as a weak tornado.
- ✓ Isolated large hail is also possible.
- ✓ Isolated flooding is possible, especially where storms train over the same areas.

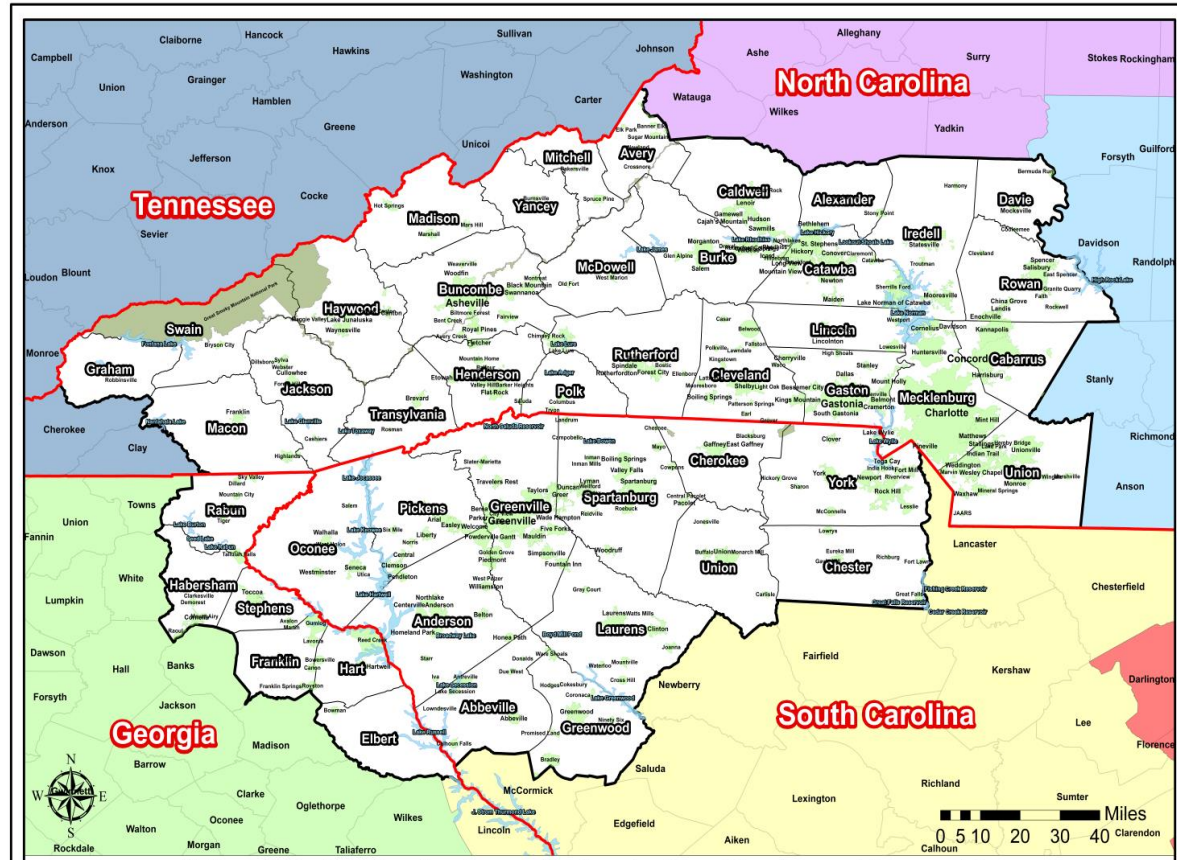

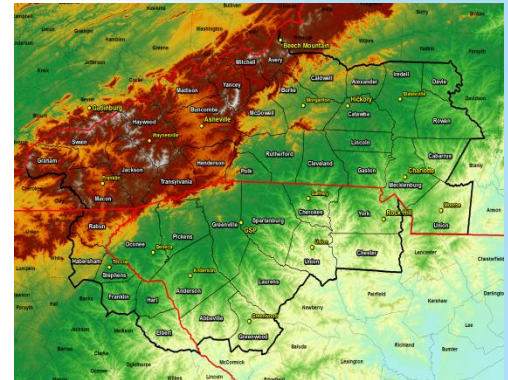
